Introduction

These release notes describe changes and upgrades to the Mackie DLZ Creator firmware since Version 1.1.1.

System Requirements

- Windows 10/11
- macOS 10.12 or higher required

NOTE: A flash drive or microSD card is also required for the updates.

DLZ Creator V1.2

The following is a list of items that have been added, changed or fixed since DLZ Creator V1.1.1.

- Added FX pads.
- Added control pads.
- Added firmware update improvements.
- Expanded – doubled! – the number of sample banks.
- Revised the Japanese language.
- Fixed an issue where double-tapping the pitch slider did not set the parameter to its default.
- Fixed an issue where the Edit Sample option didn't appear until navigating away from sample screen.
- Fixed an issue where the firmware update pop-up did not appear after power on.
- Fixed an issue where pressing "Back" after a factory reset would restart the factory reset.
- Fixed an issue where the bank button was still accessible while in system lock mode.
- Updated the system lock so users could only enter a 4-digit code, no more, no less.

- Fixed an issue where pressing the back button while in control mode still changed the control mode.
- Fixed an issue where pressing the forward button in the media player did not play the next available file.
- Fixed an issue where users could navigate into an unmounted SD/USB directory.

DLZ Creator V1.1.1

The following is a list of items that have been added, changed or fixed since DLZ Creator V1.1, Build 74.

- Fixed an issue where gain would reset to a lower level when the Ch3 and/or Ch4 input exceeds +6dB.

DLZ Creator V1.1

The following is a list of items that have been added, changed or fixed since DLZ Creator V1.0.2, Build 49.

- Added audio transmission via Ethernet, allowing the main mix output to be sent to Mac or PC via NDI (Network Device Interface).
- Added multi-language support.
- Fixed an issue with the Sampler Quick Display showing the incorrect status if stopped while fade in and edit end are in use.
- Fixed an issue with Auto Gain not working correctly when the input signal exceeds +4dBu.
- Fixed an issue where double tapping the currently playing file in Media Player causes file name display issues.
