



## BIG KNOB

---

**Question:** I don't get it. What is this thing, a mixer, a recording device, a headphone amp, what?

Answer: Simply put, the Big Knob is a level control, monitor switcher, source selector, and talkback box, perfect for your desktop studio.

**Question:** How many ins and outs does the Big Knob have?

Answer: You can select between 4 stereo inputs (INS) and 3 sets of stereo monitors (OUTS). Not to mention 5 additional stereo outputs for everything from headphone mixers, DAWs, and the like.

**Question:** Is there separate level control for each monitor/speaker output?

Answer: Yes. The Big Knob includes a separate adjustable trim pot on each monitor/speaker output. This allows you to match the output of the Monitor connectors to unbalanced, -10 dB inputs, balanced +4 dB inputs, and anything in between.



**Question:** Can the Big Knob be rack mounted?

Answer: Currently there is no rack mount option available for the Big Knob. However, there are rack mount ear-holes built in so that we have the option of manufacturing a rack mounting kit at a later date should we get enough demand for it. Please contact us and let us know if you're interested in that as a future option!

**Question:** Can I use a line level signal other than a record player on the Phono input?

Answer: Since the Phono input uses an RIAA preamp to properly reproduce music from a record, you will not be able to plug in any line level device without some modification to the signal first. The RIAA preamp has EQ curves built-in that will need to be corrected in order for your music to sound right. You will need to build a circuit to make this work.
